EDPM desirable amenities provided at railway station.

2. Provide details of different categories of railway
stations on basis of passenger footfall or any other
EDPM criteria being used. What kind of amenities and
infrastructural facilities are associated with
different categories of railway stations?

3. Whether the Indian Railways is developing any
Railway Stations on the Public-Private-Partnership
mode. Kindly give details of such stations, which
EDGS/SD have been developed and are proposed to be
developed. Kindly share the details of special
facilities and amenities provided/proposed to be
provided. Will the Indian Railways have any
supervisory role in the management of such
Stations, kindly elaborate.

4. What are the significant challenges in providing
EDPM recommended and desirable amenities at smaller
stations or those with lesser volume of passengers
or lower earnings?

5. What monitoring mechanisms are in place to assess the effectiveness and quality of amenities provided at railway stations?
